Tournament Conditions

1. Aims to encourage participation in Scottish Squash Age Group Squash Tournaments.
2. Players enter and play in the Bridge of Allan Sports Club Open Masters Squash Championships at their own risk. Scottish Squash, Bridge of Allan Sports Club and any other Club or facility associated with the tournament do not accept any responsibility for injury arising from participation in the tournament. Competitors who are not Competitive Player Members of Scottish Squash are advised to arrange their own Personal Accident insurance cover.
3. Entry Fees:
  - 3.1 **Members of Scottish Squash**
    - Individual 'Competitive Player Members of Scottish Squash', and 'Competitive Player Members of a Member Club', are eligible for the lower entry fee of £10 per competitor.
  - 3.2 **Non-Members of Scottish Squash**
    - Where the players' home club is not a member of Scottish Squash and the player is not an Individual Competitive Player Member, the entry fee will be £15:50p per competitor.
    - Following the event the Tournament Director will forward details of Non Members, along with a fee of £5:50p per person, (funded from the higher tournament entry fee) to Scottish Squash. This will qualify these individuals to be a 'Club Player/Supporter Members' of Scottish Squash.
  - 3.3 **Club Player/Supporter Members**
    - Club Player/Supporter Members will pay the £5:50p levy in subsequent tournaments. This levy will also be forwarded to Scottish Squash.
4. Scottish Squash Code of Conduct and Fair Play Statement will apply.
5. Age qualification date, for all age groups, shall be player's age at the start date of the tournament.
6. Player must contact the organisers, immediately, when availability problems arise.
7. Players must check-in at the 'Tournament Desk' at least 30 minutes before their scheduled match time.
8. No player will be allowed on court if their entry fee remains unpaid.
9. The tournament will run on a knock out basis.
10. Draws will be seeded in accordance with the current ranking lists and at the discretion of the tournament organisers.

11. Draws will be posted on the Bridge of Allan Sports Club website, [www.boasc.com](http://www.boasc.com), any player providing a SAE will receive notification by post. The organisers reserve the right to amend the draws at their discretion to accommodate withdrawals.
12. Players should be warmed-up and ready for a prompt start, 15 minutes prior to their scheduled time.
13. The English Scoring system shall be used for all matches, first to 9 points, best of 5 games.
14. The Dunlop Pro **xx** yellow-dot squash ball shall be used in all matches.
15. All players are expected to mark games, preferably two matches following their own match.
16. To encourage players to mark matches they shall receive a raffle ticket for each match they mark. A draw will take place during the presentation for a top of the range Titan Squash Racket.
17. This is a Scottish Squash Masters Circuit Tournament that carries ranking points towards Scottish Team selection.
18. If entries numbers are sufficient Plate Competitions shall be organised to allow first round losers to have at least two matches.
19. Players wishing to enter the plate must notify the organisers immediately after their first round match.
20. Prize money and other prizes may be awarded to certain events, the amount and event(s) selected, shall be at the sole discretion of the tournament organisers.
21. Only in exceptional circumstances will entry fees be refunded.
22. Late entries will be accepted provided slots available otherwise, late entries shall be placed on a reserve list awaiting cancellations.
23. Advertised times of matches should be regarded as a guide only. Courts will not be allocated to matches. Matches will follow immediately after preceding matches, wherever possible, using a 'Next Available Court' system.
24. The decision of the Tournament Organiser will be final.
